FIRST CIRCULAR

We have the pleasure to announce that the Fourth Workshop of the Nuclear Spectroscopy Instrumentation Network of ENSAR2, NUSPIN 2019, will take place in Orsay on June 24th-28th 2019, and will host the AGATA Collaboration Meeting.

NuSpIn is a network of ENSAR2 that aims at promoting the mutual coordination between the research groups involved in high-resolution gamma-ray spectroscopy. The objective is to strengthen the nuclear structure community by the exchange and transfer of knowledge and the enhancement of synergies between the different collaborations active in the European Infrastructure Facilities.

The aim of the NUSPIN 2019 Workshop is to present the status of nuclear structure research in Europe and to discuss its perspectives. Sessions will be dedicated to the presentation of recent theoretical studies, the latest results obtained at the international gamma-ray facilities, and the discussion of the challenges of future research, the development of new instrumentation and technical developments with gamma-ray techniques and particle detectors.

Review talks are planned with ample time scheduled for discussion. These reviews will be followed by shorter contributions selected from the submitted abstracts.

The afternoon of Wednesday 26th June will be devoted to the meetings of the NUSPIN Scientific Committee and of the Working Groups coordinating the instrumentation developments.

Annual Meeting of the AGATA Collaboration

The afternoon of Thursday 27th June and the morning of June 28th will be dedicated to the Annual Meeting of the AGATA Collaboration, and the closed meeting of the AGATA Collaboration Council.

WORKSHOP VENUE

The workshop will be held in Orsay, France. Orsay is situated about 25 km south of Paris.

The workshop will take place in the Amphithéâtre of the Institut de Physique Nucléaire d'Orsay (IPNO) in building 100 of the Orsay University Campus. It is situated a few minutes walking distance from the RER B metro station Orsay Ville.
