SECOND CIRCULAR

The NUSPIN 2019 Workshop will take place in Orsay on June 24th-28th 2019, and will host the AGATA Collaboration Meeting.

The aim of the NUSPIN 2019 Workshop is to present the status of gamma-spectroscopy research in Europe and to discuss its perspectives. Sessions will be dedicated to the presentation of recent theoretical studies, the latest results obtained at international gamma-ray facilities, the discussion of the challenges of future research and the development of new instrumentation for nuclear spectroscopy and nuclear reactions.

Review talks are planned with ample time scheduled for discussion. These reviews will be followed by shorter contributions selected from the submitted abstracts.
